I have been sought out to meet with victim advocacy groups that work on legislation every session and want me to become involved and make our stalking/arson case public to help their cause. As I have looked over the details of this case this has the potential to look very poorly on the department and I'm coming to you to try to find a diplomatic resolution to this. My family is in grave danger and I desperately need help. I have my first meeting with the organization leader later this afternoon and I truly don't want to be meeting someone explaining the case and how it has been handled by the police department.
